GETTING STARTED

Windows

1 - Connect the included power cord to the power jack on the Docking Station.

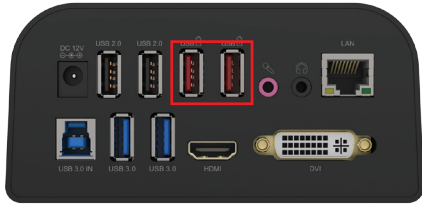


2 - Plug the other end of the power cord to a power outlet.





Note: You can utilize your Docking Station as a standalone charging station by attaching devices to one of the charging ports (RED).



3 - Insert the included USB 3.0 data cable into the USB 3.0 port on the Docking Station.

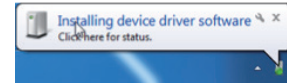


4 - Connect the other end of the USB 3.0 cable to an available USB port on your PC or tablet.



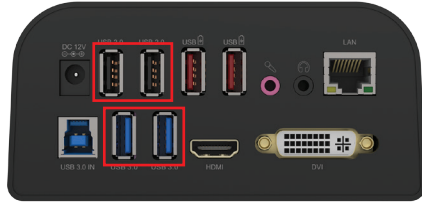
Note: While the **Sabrent Docking Station is Plug & Play**, we strongly recommend downloading and installing the latest display drivers by visiting <http://www.displaylink.com/downloads>

5 - Allow up to 5 minutes for the Plug & Play feature to finish the driver installation.





6 - **USB 3.0 (BLUE)** and **USB 2.0 (BLACK)** Data Ports are now ready for use.



7 - You can also connect audio devices to the sound ports on the Docking Station.



Note: You may need to disable your onboard sound card or set “**USB Audio**” to default on your sound settings.

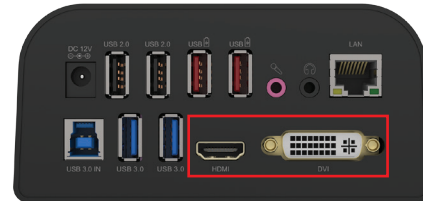


8 - Connect an Ethernet cable from your router or modem to the network port on the Docking Station for a Wired Network Connection.



Note: If you are unable to connect to the network, try powering off your router and modem for 30 seconds then powering them back up with network cable connected to the Docking Station.

9 - Add up to two additional monitors or TVs via HDMI, DVI, or VGA by attaching them to a video port on the Docking Station. This device supports extended desktop and desktop mirroring.



Note: Displays should automatically install when connected. Customize display settings in Display settings.



Mac

- 3 - Follow the steps and restart your computer.
